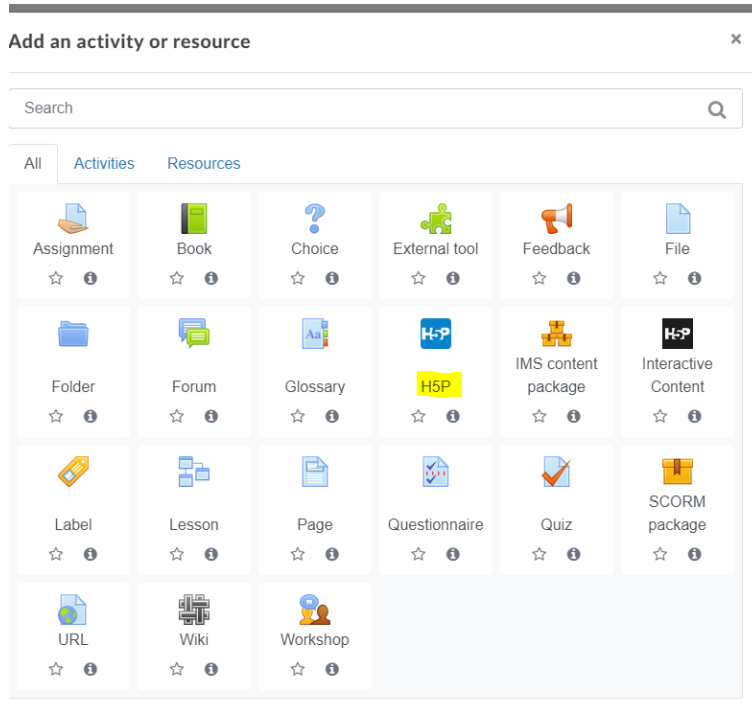


- 1) To add an H5P activity, click on 'Add an Activity or Resource' and select the H5P icon.

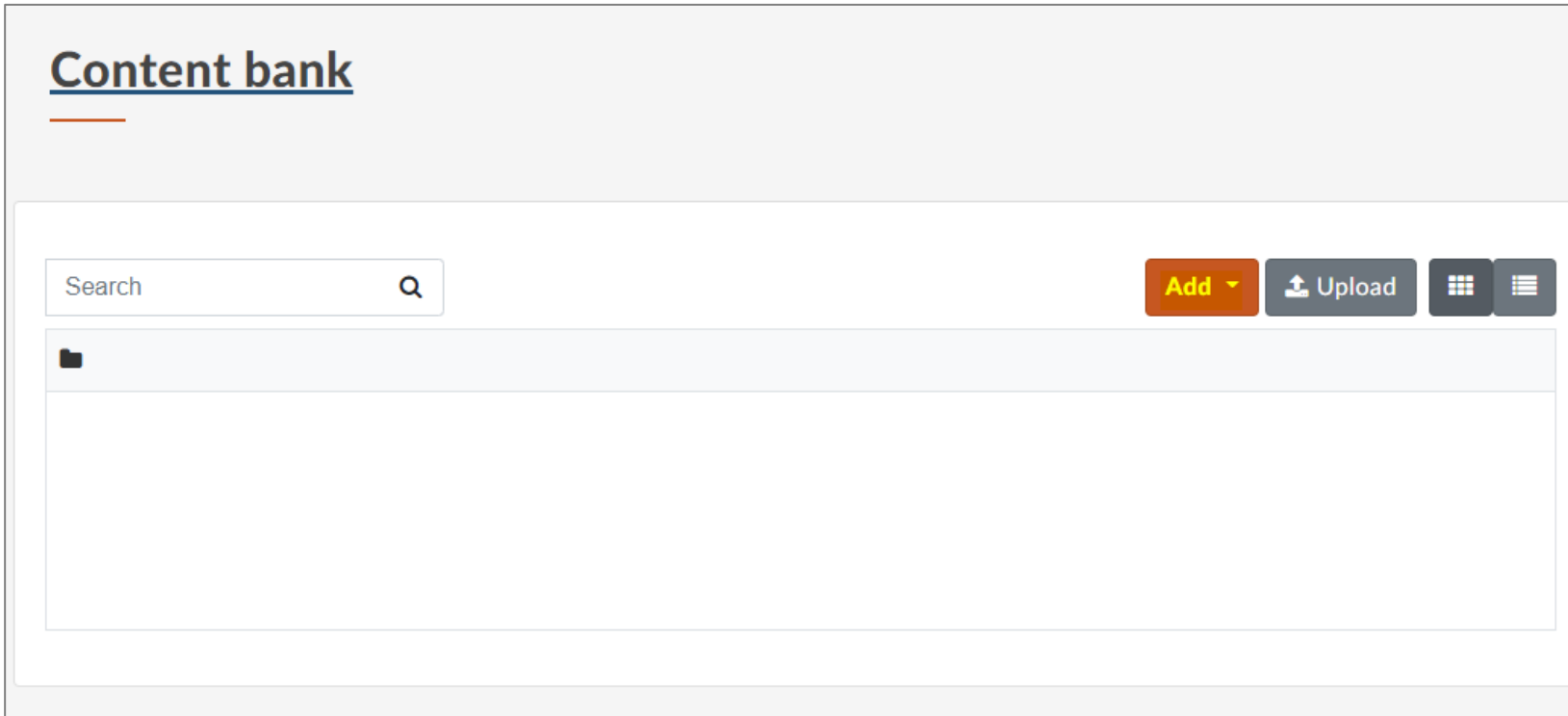

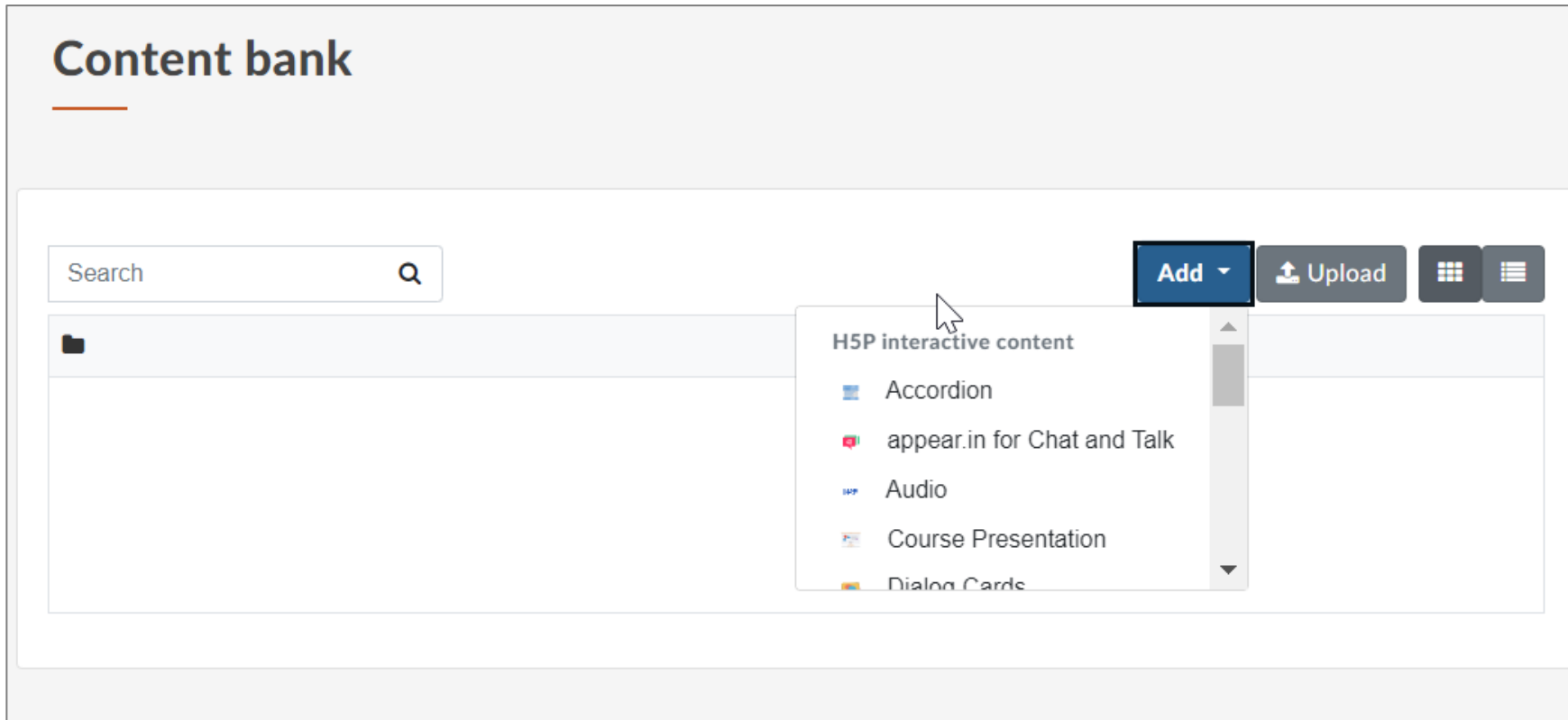
2) In activity settings, in the package file section, click on the content bank link.


3) In the Content Bank window, click on the 'Add' button to open a dropdown menu.

4) Select an H5P activity type from the dropdown menu.

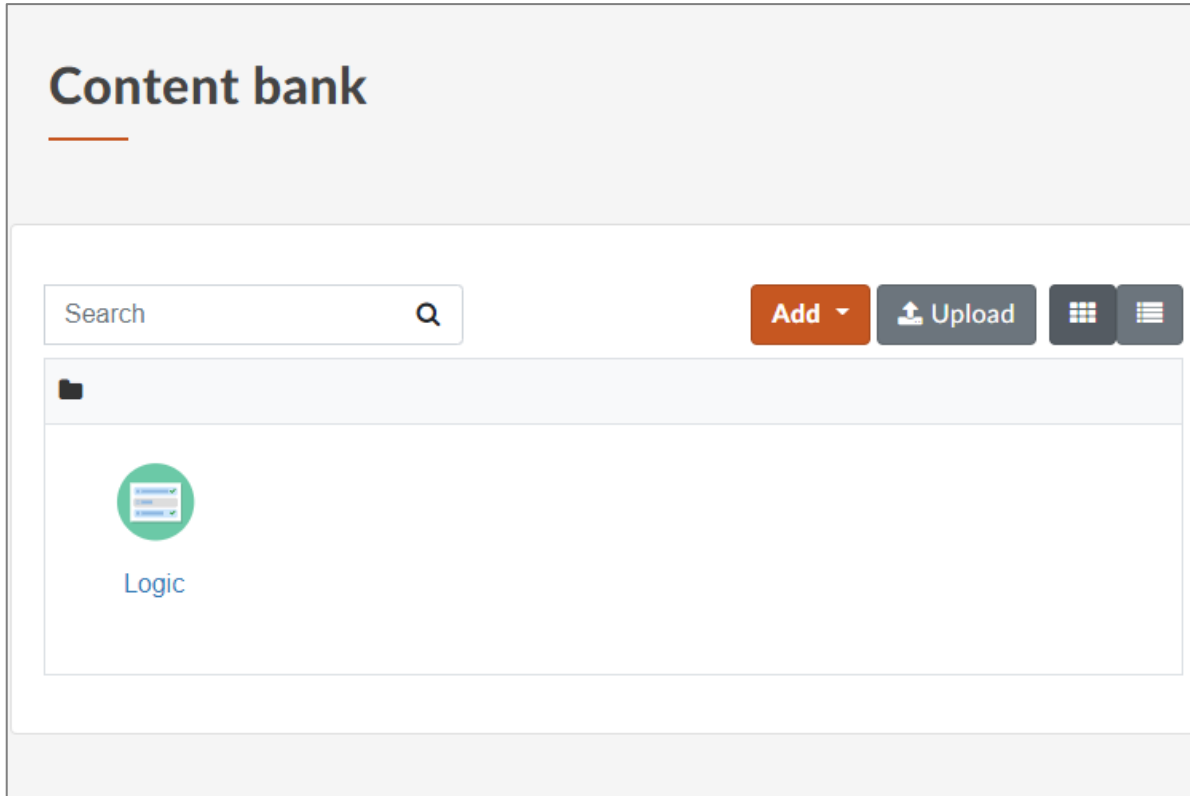


8) Using the File Picker, click on Content Bank and select the H5P activity from the list.

9) After returning to activity settings, the selected H5P file should appear in Package File settings. Click on 'Save and Display' to save changes.




