Learning Hub Online Course Completion Setting Guide

Overview

Before your course goes live, make sure all course settings are set up properly. There are **two completion settings** that must be reviewed.

- 1. Activity Completion Setting: Check the Module's Activity Completion setting in Moodle to make sure it is tracking completion for each module.
- 2. Course Completion Settings: Check the Course's Completion setting in Moodle to make sure the course is tracking all required activities.

Please make sure you test the course with test accounts to ensure course completion is generated.


